<u>Series</u>: John's Portrait of Jesus <u>Scripture</u>: John 15:1-17 <u>Title:</u> "**I am the True Vine**"

In the final 'I am...' passage, Jesus adopts a metaphor familiar to most Israelites from the Old Testament (Psalm 80; Ezekiel 15 and 17; Isaiah 5; 11:1; 27:2-4; Hosea 10:1). Just as salvation came through Israel then, now salvation will come through Jesus, Israel's Messiah. Jesus, in the passage for today, expands and explains the metaphor and paints a compelling portrait of what life in community with Christ looks like.
