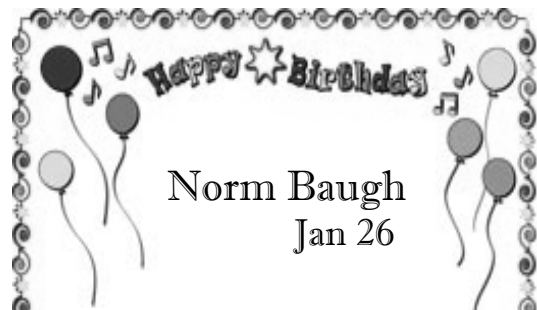

Work as Worship

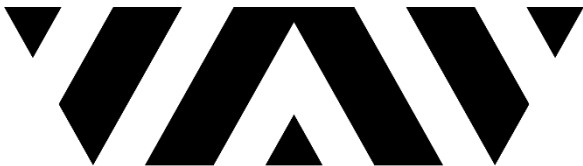
