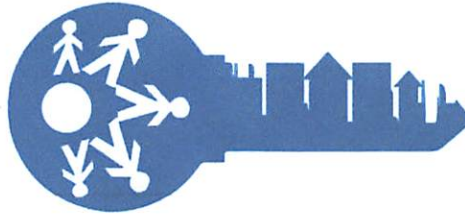

Dear parishioners,

On behalf of the Task Force To End Homelessness in Burnaby and Lookout Housing and Health, it is our pleasure to thank Westminster Bible Chapel for opening your doors and giving such warm church hospitality when cold weather puts people who sleep on the streets at high health risk.

This past Extreme Weather Response (EWR) season provided 260 bednights of service and opened 60 nights, despite Burnaby now having a temporary shelter and overnight warming centres. This demonstrates how crucial these extreme weather spaces are to provide refuge and comfort for those who have few, if any housing options. We sheltered adults and seniors, men and women. In fact, one in five were women. All who stayed were grateful; they came with nothing, but leave warm, with a full stomach and with the knowledge that people do care about them!

Many members of your congregation volunteer in the EWR regularly; every night it was open volunteers supported the service! We particularly want to acknowledge and thank Marianne Buesink and Kathy Baugh who do so much, including recruiting, training and coordinating other volunteers. They are core members of the EWR work group that has the responsibility of developing the annual Burnaby Extreme Weather Plan that guides this essential community service. Marianne and Kathy coordinate the space and food, working in close partnership with Lookout's team of experienced shelter staff.

It is through the support of many that we can continue to provide services for Burnaby's homeless population, and we are honoured and appreciative that Westminster Bible Chapel continues to be so supportive and dedicated.

Together, we will End Homelessness In Burnaby! Thank you.
