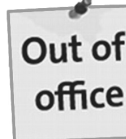

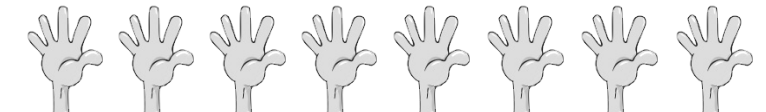

## International Lefthanders Day is August 13

- ◆ This day was designated in 1996 to bring awareness to the difficulties of being a lefty in a right-handed world.
- ◆ *Sinistophobia* is defined as a fear of either left handed people or objects located on the left side.
- ◆ Lefties make up roughly 12% of the population.
- ◆ Mothers who give birth over the age of 40 are 128% more likely to have a child with left-handedness than a woman who has a baby in her 20s.
- ◆ Lefties are more likely to be male.
