August 20 is **World Mosquito Day**

- ◆ Established in 1897 when the link between mosquitoes and malaria transmission was discovered by British doctor Sir Ronald Ross and aims to raise awareness and prevention of the disease.
- ◆ Other diseases spread by mosquitoes: Dengue, Chikungunya, Yellow Fever, Encephalitis, Zika, West Nile Virus.
- ◆ Only female mosquitoes feed on human blood while the male ones feed on nectar.
- ◆ Mosquitoes are the deadliest animals on earth. Approximately 6 million deaths every decade occur owing to malaria alone.
- ◆ The maximum lifespan of a mosquito is 5-6 months.
- ◆ Mosquitoes need water to breed but not much. Make it a point to frequently check around your home and garden spaces to remove any standing water!
